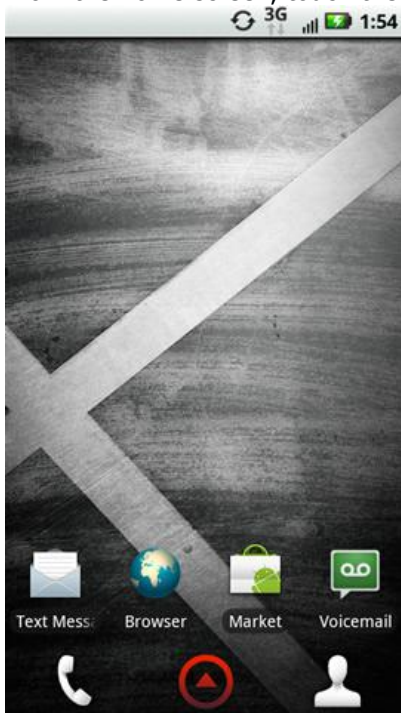
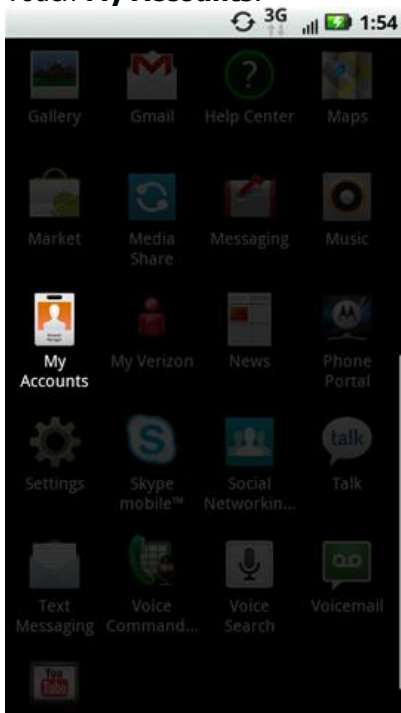


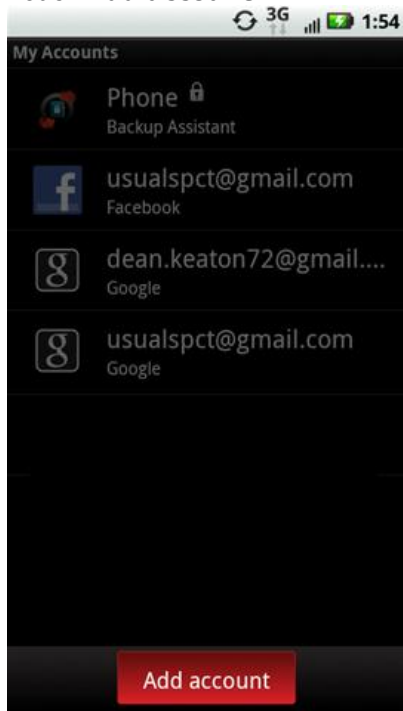
1. From the home screen, touch the **applications tab** (located at the bottom of the display).



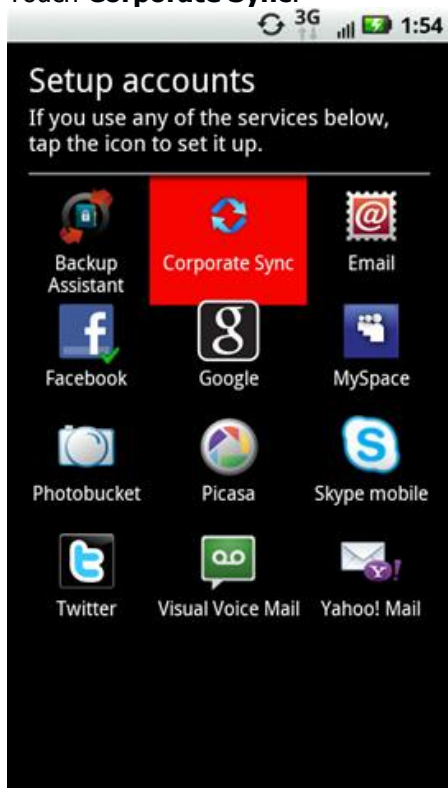
